


Required Courses

The following courses will <u>automatically</u> be scheduled on your child's

schedule next year:

- Integrated English Language Arts
- Math**
- American History
- Science
- Lunch
- Advisory

** The math class that you take next year depends on what you are taking now. Math 7 students will be scheduled in Math 8. Accelerated 7/8 students will be scheduled in Algebra I. Algebra I is a high school course and you will earn 1 high school credit after successful completion.

World Language Courses

Level 1: French, German or Spanish: full year (36 weeks) course:

A year-long accelerated course with optional high school credit. Level I will introduce grammatical structures, vocabulary and culture topics of immediate interest and use are introduced. Listening, speaking, reading, writing, and culture are all integral parts of the course; therefore, this course is recommended for students earning a **B or above** in their current seventh grade English Language Arts course. Upon successful completion of this Level 1 Foreign Level course (80% B- or better) students may take Level II in the ninth grade. It also gives the students an opportunity to complete a five-year language sequence (possible AP credit at the 5th level) before graduating.



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Word Language...more information

- French I, German I, and Spanish I are high school level classes that are worth one elective credit toward graduation.
- Taking a World Language is the equivalent of taking a **5**th**core** class. In **7**th grade, students have 4 core classes.
- Homework is daily. A minimum of 20 minutes should be spent outside of class working on World Language.
 Some students will need 30-45 minutes.
- These classes move quickly! An 80% average for the year is the high school expectation to continue on to level
 II.
- Students will be learning all skills in the World Language: Listening / Reading / Writing / and Speaking.
- World Language is not a requirement to graduate; however, 3 years of 1 language or 2 years of 2 languages are required for the Honors Diploma.
- Many universities require foreign language, usually 2-3 years, as an entrance requirement.
- Students who take World Language are taking a rigorous curriculum and are on their way to being college and career ready.



What to consider before enrolling in 8thgrade World Language:

- What is your interest level in learning a second language?
- What kind of study habits and organizational skills do you have?
- Are you willing to put forth the effort in a 5thcore class (language) the entire year?
- What outcome do you expect? Are you planning to take at least 3-5 years to be career and college ready?
- Students who are strong in ELA and math tend to be more successful in World Language at the middle school level.
- It is a year course that is similar to a math class, everything you learn builds on prior knowledge.
 You do not get a fresh start each quarter you need to master all material to meet the 80% mastery expectation to go on to level II. It is important to be proactive: if you are having difficulty, you need to seek help!
- Consider how wonderful you will feel when you can begin to communicate with other people in another language!



Do I have to take a World Language in middle school?

- World Language courses are year-long (36 week) classes.
- It is like taking a 5th Core class. Please review the World Language information before you make a decision.
- If your Integrated English grade is lower than a B, it may be best for you to wait until high school to take this course.

 - Example A: If you only select 3 electives [i.e., PE, Drawing, and Global Gourmet I]. You will be scheduled in 3 study halls.
 - Example B: If you do not select any elective courses like PE, Health, Eagle News, then you will be scheduled in a full-year study hall [36 weeks].

STEP 1: Prepare

- Talk with your guardian(s) about the scheduling process and due dates
- Review the Elective Course Descriptions
- Discuss courses that are best for YOU and your interests

STEP 2: Enter course requests in PowerSchool


- Elective Courses: Enter your elective courses in PowerSchool.
- Remember, study halls are automatically scheduled, you do not have to select study halls.

STEP 3: Scheduling Due Dates


- All course selections should be entered in PowerSchool by Tuesday, February 2nd.
- The last day to make changes to your schedule is Friday, May 21st.

THE Online SCHEDULING PROCESS PowerSchool Step Sheet


1. Log-in to PowerSchool through My OLSD. Click "Class Registration" icon on the left.



2. Click the "Pencil icon" for each course group and select the classes you would like for the following year [Note: only electives, music, and world language can be selected]. The remaining courses will be automatically scheduled.



3. In each course group, select the classes you would like to request. Once you select your course(s), click "Okay" to enter your requests




4. After you have made all of your requests for each course group, click "Submit" on the bottom right-hand side of the screen to save your requests.

5. You can review all of your course requests for the upcoming school year, under "Class Registration" in Power School at anytime. Remember, this is NOT YOUR SCHEDULE, rather a list of courses you are requesting. While we do everything we can to grant your requests, we can not guarantee you will get all of your classes. Your schedule will be available in Power School in August.

Sports

• 8th Graders are eligible to participate in sports. Please see Mrs. Burgan for sports related questions.



What is 8th Grade like?

8th grade is very similar to 7th grade, but **Better**. You will be on TEAMS like in 7th grade. However, you will be in the **White** House instead of in the Blue house. 8th graders have more elective course options and you can participate in sports. You will also take a trip to Washington, D.C.

- Teams work the same way in 8th grade
 - PowerSchool randomly places students on Teams.
